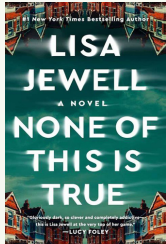

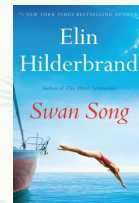

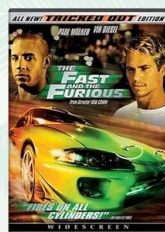

must save the day--and their way of life.*



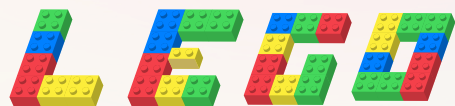

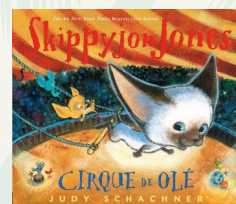


Paw Patrol: Sea Patrol to the Rescue!
